TAXI

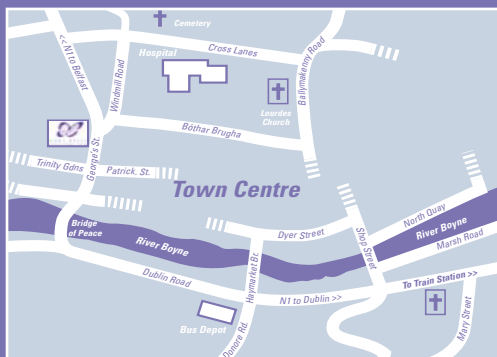
The centre has an arrangement with a local taxi company and we can organise this service at your request.
